
INDICTMENT FOR

TRAFFICKING METHAMPHETAMINE
§44-53-375(C)

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on the 25th day of February, 2022, the Grand Jurors of Abbeville County present upon their oath:

The defendant, Kenneth Dewayne McGaha, did on or about December 10, 2021, in Abbeville County, South Carolina, knowingly sell, manufacture, deliver, purchase, or bring into this State, or did provide financial assistance or otherwise aid, abet, attempt, or conspire to sell, manufacture, deliver, purchase, or bring into this State, or was knowingly in actual or constructive possession or knowingly attempted to become in actual or constructive possession of four hundred (400) grams or more of methamphetamine as defined and otherwise limited in Section 44-53-110, 44-53-210(d)(1), or 44-53-210(d)(2), all in violation of 44-53-375(C), Code of Laws of South Carolina (1976, as amended).

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such cases made and provided.
