ORDER

On January 31, 2025, the court granted Respondent's second motion to strike and ordered Appellant to serve and file a second amended record on appeal. Appellant filed the second amended record on appeal on February 19, 2025. On March 21, 2025, Appellant moved to amend Volumes V and VI of the record on appeal to correct errors in page numbers and missing pages. Respondent filed a return, indicating it did not oppose the motion but requesting fourteen days following an order granting the motion so that it can correct any page references in Respondent's final brief made necessary by the motion and proposed amended record on appeal. After careful consideration, we grant Appellant's motion to amend record on appeal volumes V and VI, and we grant Respondent fourteen days from the date of this order in which to file Respondent's amended final brief in order to correct any page references.

On March 31, 2025, Respondent moved to strike Appellant's final brief, arguing the brief did not comply with Rule 211 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules because it contained substantive changes from Appellant's initial brief. Appellant did not file a return. After careful consideration, we grant Respondent's motion. Appellant shall serve and file an amended final brief that is identical to Appellant's initial brief. *See* Rule 211(b) ("The final brief(s) shall be identical to the brief(s) previously served under Rule 208, except for the following: (1) References to the Record . . . [and] (2) Correction of Typographical Errors and Misspellings.").
