
Mr. Jackson:

This is in reference to the above correspondence. South Carolina Attorney General Russ Barlow has been the one assigned by the Court to draft the Order in the above referenced case. I spoke with his office today. They indicated that the Order has not been prepared and did not provide a timeline for completion. It is my understanding they are very busy with such work.

Upon receipt of the Order, our office plans to provide an in-house legal opinion on the document, schedule any changes and provide possible approval in whole or part to the Attorney General. It is also our plan to appeal any negative decision against you to the Supreme Court and copy the South Carolina Commission on Appeals, Indigent Division. They can serve possibly as your appellate counsel in this matter. They can request the transcript of our hearing and review any issues arising from that hearing in my opinion. In my view, we went over the topics thoroughly in that hearing and appellate counsel can discuss that with you in depth.

MR. FOWLER: Yes, sir.

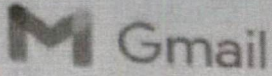

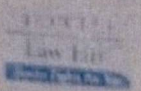
