

ORDER


Petitioner has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari seeking review of the court of appeals' order awarding attorney's fees and costs to Respondents. We have construed the petition as a request for a common law writ of certiorari to be heard in our original jurisdiction. Because there are no questions of public interest, emergency, or other good reason for this Court to entertain the matter in our original jurisdiction, we decline to do so. *See* Rule 245(a), SCACR (providing this Court will not entertain matters in its original jurisdiction unless the public interest is involved or special grounds of emergency or other good reasons exist); *Key v. Currie*, 305 S.C. 115, 406 S.E.2d 356 (1991) (holding this Court will not entertain matters in its original jurisdiction unless there is an extraordinary reason such as a question of significant public interest or an emergency).




