I certify I filed a similar affidavit of in forma pauperis with the Court of Common Pleas on 3/1/24 and it was granted. It was later rescinded upon the dismissal of the case.

I filed a similar affidavit with the Court of Appeals on 10/24/24 and it was denied 4/23/25, which was also on the dismissal of the case. I'd sent them an unpaid bill which I believe they never considered, as I'd made eight (8) motions/requests to remove it from the public index, and all 8 were never acknowledged. It is still in the public index.

I request this court to reverse that decision and grant me in forma pauperis, as I'm unable to pay any fees, and allow me my constitutional right to appeal regardless of my financial ability.
