Dear Ms. Kitchings:

Enclosed herein is a \$50.00 money order for the filing fee for the Motion Opposing Two Deficiency Letters which we mailed to your office on Friday, May 16, 2025 (Certified Mail No. 7022 2410 0003 3777 1961), and which was inadvertently left out of the packet.

We enclose the original Proof of Service, From 7, to all attorneys. Additionally, we enclose the filing fee for our Motion opposing two Deficiency Letter demands to you.

Further, we Motioned the Court on May 1, 2025, an expansion of time and pages on all matters due to Disabilities and requested Reasonable Accommodation for same, to include more time/pages if necessary, regarding all Deficiency letters, including what we have already received and answered since that request, as we are not able to work that fast and need more space than permitted at times, for good cause, when necessary.

We have further requested this time/increased pages due to the clearly unconscionable, Unconstitutional, and extremely unnecessary and unlawfully created complexity of our case, caused by the alleged government and other RACKETEERS, making Plaintiffs focus on procedural and substantive fraud and manipulations by the Court, and more importantly, extreme fraud against Plaintiffs Unalienable rights that cannot be given or taken from them by government, but were anyway, in order to predetermine the outcome of this case by whatever means necessary, even in the most outrageous ways, due to their financial and other inappropriate interests that even involved conspiring with another jurisdiction having nothing to do with this original personal suit against the original Defendants.

We would like fair and unbiased rulings on the motions as soon as possible, without requesting extra oral argument since, if unfairly denied these extremely corrective motions, the time and energy taken to prepare for oral argument will just take more of our time and limited physical ability from preparing the brief, and Designation of Matters

and so forth, that are already dates coming up more quickly than we can reasonably accomplish as it is.

The lower court excelled in keeping us occupied on secondary matters so we could not focus or give the most physical energy we had to our work at hand on our case, knowing they sufficiently weakened our physical ability to keep us from being as effective as we could be. Even then, we still won the case, but for the judges refusing to acknowledge our wins as of law, but we do not want to get sucked into that strategy vortex again, taking up valuable time and energy, and need fair and unbiased proceedings and findings on our motions, which writings scream fraud on the Court and Persons, without oral argument.

We do reaffirm that our submission of Orders in response to the Deficiency Demand recently, are a part of our respectful compliance, while still demanding we receive more time even for that submission (see motions), to provide us more time and proper review, as we could not determine if what we submitted is going to be all we want to submit, since many Orders were made ex parte without us present, but only Defense involved, and/or without our knowledge even after the fact, and we may not have included some of that blitz against our rights in this submission as this will take time to review more of the record, often without any notice to us at all, by Judges/Defense.

We were under siege as a part of that predetermined outcome strategy for the RACKETEERS to win by any means, while never allowing us to receive Discovery Requests, Depositions or any other form of questioning of some of the Defendant RACKETEERS who were also involved, which blocking information lasted the full 3 years of this case. We were not allowed to bring our case forward or win obvious wins against Defense on procedure where they could not even comply with the rules. Judges refusing to Enter Judgements for us when the Defense repeatedly defaulted, was part of the proof that we were not allowed to win or get information of the RACKETEERING involvement of the Judges, lawyers, carrier, and so forth, through any questioning of the Defendants on any matter, who were also involved in the RACKETEERINGS per their own written and recorded oral statements we had procured outside of Discovery to make this case a very troubling state corruption case that needs to be investigated and us made whole.
