Apologies for not being able to get back to you sooner, as I've been out of the office for a number of days.

For the transcript request, I will need for you to submit an online request, found [here](#). I believe this will be the best route since our ordering system will give you an automatic email confirming the Commission's receipt. Since no one else has ordered the transcript heretofore, there are a couple of specific things you should know.

When you are filling out the request information, there will be a question as to whether you require an estimate of cost for the transcript. PLEASE answer "Yes" to that question. Based on the estimate that I will then send to you, you can submit a request for waiver of fees. You can then outline the reasons for that requested waiver, send that to me, and I will forward to our Chief Clerk who must make the final decision in such situations.

So that I understand, when you reference needing the “entire docket paper version and an electronic version,” are you still referring to the transcript of the hearing? I ask because the “entire docket” would include many other documents pertaining to the case which have been filed with the Commission but that would not necessarily be part of the transcript of the hearing record.
