MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Marcus Christopher White respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension from May 30, 2025 until June 30, 2025 in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.
2. Counsel filed the *Johnson* Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Justin A. Armstrong v. State with the Supreme Court on May 21, 2025. Counsel filed the

Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Michael J. Dennis v. State with the Supreme Court on May 20, 2025. Counsel filed the *Anders* Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Robby W. Tracy with the Court of Appeals on May 15, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Christopher A. Cravets with the Court of Appeals on May 5, 2025. Counsel appeared for Oral Argument in the case of The State v. Ray Kelly before the Court of Appeals on April 16, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Dwight A. Powell, Jr. with the Court of Appeals on April 9, 2025. Counsel appeared for Oral Argument in the case of The State v. Marcus A. Wigfall before the Court of Appeals on April 8, 2025.


3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

4. On April 30, 2025, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through May 31, 2025.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty-day extension from May 30, 2025 until June 30, 2025. Counsel respectfully requests that the time limits for filing the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.


