

## ORDER

---

This consolidated appeal arises out of an order of the circuit court directing Prisma Health to produce certain medical documents responsive to a subpoena issued by the State of South Carolina, Thirteenth Circuit Solicitor's Office. Prisma Health appeals to this Court, and has also filed a petition for extraordinary relief in the Supreme Court. After careful consideration, this appeal is dismissed as not immediately appealable. *See State v. Looper*, 421 S.C. 384, 390, 807 S.E.2d 203, 206 (2017) (dismissing appeal as premature because there is no final judgment in a criminal matter until the sentence is imposed unless there is an exception to the requirement of a final judgment); *Ex parte Whetstone*, 289 S.C. 580, 580, 347 S.E.2d 881, 881 (1986) ("An order directing a party to participate in discovery is interlocutory and not directly appealable under S.C. Code Ann. §14-3-330 [2017]."); *id.* at 581, 347 S.E.2d at 882 ("A non-party suffers no legal injury when he is ordered to participate in discovery. The necessary legal injury does not arise

until he is held in contempt."). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
