

## ORDER

On April 17, 2025, Appellant filed a motion for judicial notice and a motion to proceed IFP. Appellant then filed a motion for an extension of time in which to file his initial brief and designation of matter. Respondent did not file any returns. After careful consideration, we deny Appellant's motion for judicial notice but grant Appellant's motion for an extension of time. Appellant shall serve and file his initial brief and designation of matter within thirty days of the date of this order.
