MOTION TO REINSTATE

Appellant prays that this Honorable Court accepts this motion to reinstate this case and that

this motion is approved by this Court. The following facts, rules, and documents support this request.

Postal Service.)

REQUIREMENTS OF THE COURT

1. The Order to dismiss this case, dated May 15, 2025, and signed by Clerk Kitchings, refers to

Rules 207, 208, and 209, of the South Carolina Appellate Court. Rule 208 allows reinstatement by

fulfilling the requirements of Rule 260. Rule 260 states: "A case shall not be reinstated except by leave

of the court upon good cause shown, after notice to all parties," and requires that "a motion to

reinstate the

appeal has been actually received by the court within fifteen (15) days of the filing of the order of dismissal

(the day of filing being excluded)." The indicated 15 days is May 30, 2025, today's date. Today, this Motion for

Reinstatement is filed by email.

STATEMENT OF CASE FACTS, LAW, AND AUTHORITIES

2. It appears that Appellant is not causing a delay to the Respondent.

Respondent's attorney was dismissed on April 24, 2024, and the Appellate Court released the attorney

from this case on May 14, 2024. The heading of the ACMS index case indicates that Respondent has

not hired an attorney to represent the LLC. This order stated:

We take this opportunity to remind Respondent that it must be represented by a lawyer licensed to

practice law if it wishes to participate in the appeal. See *Renaissance Enters., Inc. v. Summit Teleser vices*,

Inc, 334 S.C. 649, 651, etc. (1999) (holding a nonlawyer may not represent a corporation in the appellate courts).

3. Appellant has been working diligently on the Initial Brief, Designation of Matter, and the Record on Appeal.

and has finished the writing and only needs to do final editing and printing.

4. Appellant apologizes to the Court for the time this Initial Brief has taken, and prays that the Court

will accept the Initial Brief which will be emailed early next week.

5. Appellant is learning the process of writing an Initial Brief while writing the Initial Brief. This has

taken extensive study of the process, the laws related to this case, and the acceptable format to present

the information to the court. The Appellant has spent almost four months in this process.

6. Additionally, the Appellant was sick through January 2025, as indicated by the requests for time extensions

which are recorded in the case index. Though testing negative for Covid, the Appellant had the lasting symptoms

of Covid.

7. The Appellant prays that the Court receives the Initial Brief, the Designation of Matter, and the Record on

Appeal because orders on which this appeal is based violate the facts or the case, the laws of South Carolina,

the Constitutions of the United States and South Carolina, and numerous precedent decisions.

8. Appellant requests that the court reinstates the case for the following reasons.

(a) The orders being appealed violate my U.S. Constitutional rights and my South Carolina

Constitutional

Rights and the South Carolina Statutory rights.

(b) Numerous intentional misrepresentation of material fact were made.

(c) This case reveals violation of the standards of abuse of discretion, bias and prejudgment by the court, ex parte

actions are indicated, in addition to the violation of the Appellant's Constitutional Rights.
