

NOTICE OF APPEAL

Samuel L. McPherson appeals the judgment of the Honorable Frank R. Addy, Jr. dated June 27, 2013 and filed on July 22, 2013. The Appellant received written notice of entry of the Order (Judgment) on July 26, 2013. The Appellant filed and served the Notice of Motion and Motion to Alter or Amend Judgment on Respondents and the Trial Judge on August 2, 2013. Subsequently Appellant filed a Motion To Take Depositions Pending Appeal on August 30, 2013. A Hearing was held on September 5, 2013 regarding the Motion To Alter Or Amend A Judgment and the Motion To Take Depositions Pending Appeal. The Trial Judge denied Appellant's Motion To Alter or Amend The Summary Judgment decision by Order dated September 6, 2013 and filed on September 11, 2013. The Appellant received a filed written notice of the Order denying The Motion To Alter or Amend The Judgment regarding the Summary Judgment motion on September 16, 2013. The Trial Judge subsequently denied Appellant's Motion To Take Deposition Pending Appeal by Order dated September 24, 2013, filed September 30, 2013 and received on October 3, 2013. Appellant filed a Motion To Alter or Amend the Trial Judge's Order regarding the Motion To Take Depositions Pending Appeal by motion dated October 4, 2013 and filed October 4, 2013. The Respondents and the Trial Judge were served on October 4, 2013 with the Motion To Alter Or Amend. The Trial Judge denied the Motion To Alter or Amend the Judgment by Order dated October 13, 2013. The Order denying the Motion To Alter Or Amend The Judgment regarding the taking of depositions Pending Appeal has not been filed as of October 15, 2013. This appeal relates to both motions to Alter Or Amend The Judgment.


