ORDER

On April 16, 2025, Respondents moved to exclude the deposition of Dr. Samies from the record on appeal. Respondent explained that although this court struck the transcript of the deposition of Dr. Samies from Appellant's designation of matter on February 26, 2025, because this court ruled not to strike Appellant's matter #6, "Claimant/Appellant's Reply to Respondent's Return—which had a copy of the deposition attached to it as an exhibit—Appellant intends to include the deposition in the record on appeal. Respondents alternatively ask that if this court does not exclude the deposition from the record on appeal that it allow Respondent to file a sur-reply, addressing the deposition and other issues raised in Appellant's initial reply brief. Appellant filed a return, opposing the motion. Respondent filed a reply. After careful consideration, we deny Respondent's motion to exclude the deposition of Dr. Samies from the record on appeal.
