**NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR REPORTERS RECORD DENIED, AND MOTION TO CORRECT DOCKET**

**Appellant, John S. Stritzinger after the conclusion of his appellate action in the Circuit Court of South Carolina where he had cross-criminal claims as legal defenses, was denied three motions in Limine which are in the reporters record:**

- a) Motion for Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law was denied, however the Judge stated she believed the trial below in the Probate action was sufficiently tried and had sufficient resources.
- b) Motion for Reconsideration/Retrial was not answered by the court and has effectively expired as an operation of law.
- c) Motion to provide the Court Record – was explicitly denied in Limine on April 14<sup>th</sup> as it was a medical trial and the court said it was on tapes which could not be discovered by normal litigants.

Appellant believes he has complied with State law and is asking the court for an order to compel the reporters record which is available at the Circuit Level, but not the original trial on the merits in the Probate court where there is no record at all. A Second request was made this fine day to Athena Border of the clerks office as attached in Exhibit A.

**MOTION TO CORRECT DOCKET**


