The State with this Court on May 7, 2025. Counsel filed the Brief of Respondent in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of James L. Williford with this Court on May 1, 2025. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Myron Kareem Singleton with the Court of Appeals on April 23, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Tashan Carson with the Court of Appeals on April 16, 2025. Counsel appeared to testify at the post-conviction relief evidentiary hearing in the case of Jamal Williams v. The State via WebEx on April 14, 2025. Counsel appeared for Oral Argument in the case of The State v. Raphael Pontoo before the Court of Appeals on April 8, 2025.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
