

ORDER

On May 16, 2025, Respondents moved for Appellant to modify the record on appeal to include all matter designated by Respondents and to hold the appeal in abeyance until the record on appeal is modified.¹ Appellant filed a return, acknowledging the documents were omitted and agreeing to amend the record on appeal to include the omitted matters. Respondents filed a reply. After careful consideration, we grant Respondents' motion to the extent that we strike the record on appeal served on May 7, 2025. Within twenty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended record on appeal that includes the previously omitted matter, including: the Form 51 dated October 7, 2022; Appellant's Form 30; the full transcript of hearing before Commissioner T. Scott Beck dated February 16, 2023; Respondents' APA pp. 58-60 (Dr. Samies's *curriculum vitae*); and Appellant's notice of deposition of Mr. David Sutherland taken January 9, 2023. Appellant and Respondent shall serve and file their final briefs within twenty days of the date the record on appeal is served. *See* Rule 211(a), SCACR (" Within twenty (20) days after the service of the Record on Appeal, each party shall serve a copy of the party's final brief(s) on every other party to the appeal, and file the final brief(s) with the clerk of the appellate court.").

¹ Respondent also sought to exclude the deposition of Dr. Samies; however, in a June 3, 2025 order, this court denied a separate motion to exclude that deposition from the record on appeal.
