Dear Clerk Harrison,

I represent the Appellant in this case. In response to the Court's letter of June 3, 2025, I am writing today to advise the Court that on March 26, 2025, I mailed to the Court, two original copies of the Appellant's Final Brief (one bound and one unbound), and also filed an electronic copy that day. Subsequent to that filing, the Respondents advised me and the Court that there was a mistake in the Redacted Record on Appeal and the Supplemental Record on Appeal Under Seal, and I then made a motion on behalf on the Appellant to file an amended Redacted Record on Appeal and an amended Supplemental Record on Appeal, and that motion was granted. I then filed the Court-approved Amended Redacted Record on Appeal and the Amended Redacted Supplemental Record on Appeal Under Seal on May 13, 2025.

The Respondents made a motion to extend the filing of their Final Brief until after the filing of the amended Records on Appeal, but I did not on behalf of the Appellant, make a motion to allow the filing of an amended Appellant's Final Brief because I did not think the small change in the ROA warranted changing the Final Brief. I am willing to stand by my March 26, 2025, filed Final Brief for the Appellant. The Respondents have now filed their Final Briefs.

I am a little confused by your letter of June 3, 2025, advising that the Appellants and Respondents must file one bound copy of their Final Brief, because I already sent a bound copy in on March 26, 2025. 
