MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

Counsel for Travis Turner Young respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.

2. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Jeremy S. Cornish in the Court of Appeals on June 11, 2025. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Kenneth C. Mitchell with the Court of Appeals on June 11, 2025. Counsel filed

the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Samuel S. Horton with the Court of Appeals on June 9, 2025. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Jonathan L. Gray with the Court of Appeals on May 30, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Shanekia R. Garvin with the Supreme Court on May 19, 2025. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Derrick L. Tuten with the Court of Appeals on May 12, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Michael Mobley with the Court of Appeals on May 8, 2025. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Matthew S. Young in the Court of Appeals on April 8, 2025. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Jackie Ray Childers v. State with the Supreme Court on April 4, 2025.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

4. On May 30, 2025, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through June 30, 2025.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty-day extension. Counsel respectfully requests that the time limits for filing the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
