1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.

2. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Marc Anthony Palmer v. The State with the Court of Appeals on May 15, 2025. Counsel appeared for Oral Argument in the case of The State v. Driscoll Riggins before the Court of Appeals on May 13, 2025. Counsel


filed the Anders Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. James Heyward with the Court of Appeals on May 9, 2025. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Cyntonio T. Howard v. The State with the Supreme Court on May 7, 2025. Counsel appeared for Oral Argument in the case of The State v. Justin Hopkins before the Court of Appeals on May 6, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Emeric Hamilton with the Court of Appeals on April 30, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Nasirea Grate with the Court of Appeals on April 16, 2025. Counsel appeared for Oral Argument in the case of The State v. Quayshawn Clark before the Court of Appeals on April 10, 2025. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Andre T. Heatley, Jr. v. The State with the Supreme Court on March 14, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Denardis Kilgo with the Court of Appeals on March 5, 2025.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that his caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

4. On May 30, 2025, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through June 30, 2025.




