Re: Formal Appeal - Case Number 2024CP4601346

Your Honorable Court,

I am the appellant, Kong Jian Lin, in case number 2024CP4601346, originally filed in York County, South Carolina. I am writing to formally appeal the unfair judgment in this case. Below are the main reasons for this appeal:

1. The court issued three subpoenas to the defendant, Tony Lin, who failed to appear twice, showing complete disrespect to the authority of the court, without consequence.
2. My evidence and testimony were not properly reviewed, and the judge's decision ignored the real harm I have suffered. I was unfairly denied justice.
3. This case involves serious misconduct by police detective Eddie Wong and court clerk Donna Foster.
4. Tony Lin committed multiple crimes before and during the lawsuit, including physical assault,

fraud, and threats, but has never been held accountable.

5. I filed a police report on July 5, 2023, but I have received no resolution to date.

6. I have been followed, threatened, and harassed daily since reporting Tony, resulting in severe emotional trauma and a heart condition. I underwent heart surgery on December 26, 2024, and now live in constant fear.

7. I have been unemployed for 33 months, and lost over \$141,300 in income due to this case. I request total damages of \$3,000,000, including health and emotional suffering.

8. I strongly suspect bribery, as Tony Lin has wealth and a record of suing his own relatives for profit. I believe he bribed police and court officials, including Eddie Wong and Donna Foster, to silence my voice.

9. Donna Foster acted beyond her authority by arranging a restraining order hearing without legal basis, and refused to arrange a hearing for Tony's violations and my compensation.

I respectfully request the Court of Appeals to reopen this case, allow new evidence and witness statements, and conduct a full jury trial to deliver fair justice.
