- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, it should read as follows:

v.

South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles, Respondent.

- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The document does not contain an index as required by Rule 208, SCACR.

- The document is improperly paginated. Specifically, the pages are not numbered.
- Rule 209 of the SCACR requires the designation of matter to be served and filed at the same time the initial brief is served and filed.
