

Supplemental Statement – Witness Summary and Evidence

Witness Main Statement:

I contacted many lawyers but was blocked. Some refused to take the case after reading the police report, and others refused after calling the police station. I have no attorney, and even my interpreter was intimidated. I ask the court to uphold justice, stand with the victim, and let truth be revealed through facts and evidence, so I may receive a fair outcome.

Evidence and Explanation:

1. Police report:

Tony lied to the police, denied everything, and committed multiple offenses. Why didn't the police investigate the truth? I reasonably suspect Tony bribed the police and that both reports were fabricated. (Please ask Eddie Wong to present the recording of his interview with Tony.)

2. Eddie Wong prevented me from applying for a restraining order in court. It has been over a year — why was I denied protection?

3. On October 13, 2023, at the police station, Eddie Wong ordered another officer to intimidate me. Since then, I've been afraid to return. I've lived in fear for over a year, lost my job, suffered a mental breakdown, and developed heart disease requiring surgery. I'm barely alive. Why do they want to harm me?

4. Eddie Wong said: "Have your lawyer call me," which leads me to suspect he interfered with my legal counsel and translator. On September 18, 2024, I retained Attorney Ryan Payne. He was willing at first and even called the court. Then suddenly, he changed his mind. On September 26, he replied via Gmail, and I have reasonable suspicion that Eddie Wong's interference was involved. Can the court accept this? On October 22, Ryan Payne replied again saying, "Since Tony has no lawyer, the court may grant him discretion because he might not understand the rules." — But Tony is a business owner, even sued his own relatives for shares. Is he really ignorant? And why am I not allowed to hire a lawyer?

5. Eddie Wong, you let Tony listen to my recording — is that legal? Why would you do this? Do you want to harm me? Endanger my life?

6. Court Clerk Donna Foster also acted improperly:

- ① She knowingly arranged a hearing on a restraining order the court had no authority to issue;
- ② For over 8 months, she failed to schedule any hearing regarding the defendant's contempt of court and my damage compensation. Why? Why is she hurting me? This is terrifying.

On Wednesday July 5, 2023 I was dispatched to speak with a one Kong Jian Lin of Fort Mill, SC, regarding a past assault that occurred on March 29, 2021 at the Cherry Sushi Bar located at 4034 Charlotte Highway Clover, SC, York County. Kong reported that his boss, "Tony", Yi Tong Lin, hit him in the ribs and caused injury that lasted for several weeks. Kong had to go to the doctor and prescribed medicine for pain. Kong reported that he confronted Tony about it and Tony had him lie to an insurance company that he got hurt from a door hitting him. Kong also reported that Tony said that he has recordings of him, though it is not certain what the recordings contain. Tony denies hitting Kong.

There is a language barrier. Kong is now an American citizen but was born in China and speaks limited English. It appears that this incident has effected Kong's life in several ways. It is unknown why Kong is now coming forward with this information but it is very apparent that it has caused him emotional distress and anxiety. Kong brought with him several papers from the hospital, an affidavit in Chinese, instructions that he is looking to make a police report in English, and a recording of a conversation on a cassette tape. That tape contains a conversation of some sort between him and Tony, but, it is all in Chinese.

I will have to turn this report over to CID to look into further. A Chinese interpreter will be needed.

Add to Narrative

Detective Wong made contact with Tony to ask him a few more questions about the case. During the first interview with Tony, Tony informed detective Wong that he no longer had video surveillance of this incident due to the time frame and a kitchen fire that destroyed the surveillance video system. Detective Wong followed up and asked Tony about the fire, and when the fire occurred. According to Tony, the kitchen fire happened August of 2021. Tony was asked again about workers comp insurance. Tony informed that he did call the insurance company initially. He then reported that King lied to the insurance company about the incident. According to Tony, Kong told him and the insurance company that he was hit by a refrigerator door and hurt his side. It was later discovered that the injury happened during a fight that Kong had with another employee. When Tony found out that Kong lied, the insurance claim was closed. Tony was also asked if he ever lied to the insurance company or taught King to lie to the insurance company. Tony denied ever lying to the insurance company, and denied teaching Kong how to lie to the insurance company. Kong informed that he was the owner of the company, and he had no reason to lie. He filed an insurance claim initially because Kong told him that he was hurt at work by a refrigerator door. Tony later closed the case when he found out that Kong lied to him and the injury actually came from fighting with another employee. This case will remain closed.

The York County Sheriff's Office conducted an investigation into this incident. During the course of the investigation, Detective Wong responded to the incident location to speak with Yi Tong Lin (Tony). Detective Wong sat down with Tony for an interview. Tony was informed of the allegations against him. Tony explained that he does remember the incident that is being alleged. Tony informed that he is the owner of Cherry restaurant, and he had two employees working for him. The two employees that were working on the incident date were Noy, and Kong. Tony reported that he was made aware of a situation between Noy and Kong. Tony reported that he walked into the kitchen area of the restaurant and observed Kong and Noy fighting. Tony informed me that when he observed the fight, he pushed Kong out of the kitchen and outside of the restaurant. Tony explained that the reason that he pushed Kong outside was due to all the dangers in the kitchen. Tony reported that he did not want Noy or Kong to grab a knife, or anything else that they could use as a weapon so he pushed them outside to fight. When Noy and Kong were outside, they continued to fight and yell at each other. Tony informed that he recorded the incident outside between Noy and Kong. Tony provided Detective Wong with the video recording from his phone. In the video it showed both individuals extremely angry and yelling at one another. The altercation was eventually broken up by Tony. After the altercation Tony instructed Noy to leave and go home. Kong did not appear to have any injuries. Tony was asked about video surveillance in the kitchen. Tony informed that he no longer had video because the incident occurred in 2021 and there was a fire in the kitchen that destroyed all cameras. Tony was asked if a workers comp claim was ever made for Kong. Tony reported that he did not submit any claims to the insurance company for this incident. When speaking with Kong, he reported that he did not receive any workers comp money for this incident. Case will be admin closed.
