

**NOTICE TO THE COURT OF APPEALS REGARDING PROPERTY LOSS AND
REQUEST FOR FINANCIAL DAMAGES**

To the Honorable Court:

Comes now the Appellant, Terry Clark, respectfully submitting this notice to advise the Court of Appeals of additional facts and financial loss that have occurred as a result of the recent set-out and removal of my property from the premises.

Following the execution of the writ, I discovered that, while my personal property was placed outside of the home, unauthorized individuals unlawfully accessed and stole several items belonging to myself and my minor child. Specifically, among the items stolen include:

- My child's complete clothing inventory;
- My child's personal PC computer setup;
- My child's PlayStation gaming console and accessories;
- Various other personal effects and belongings which were not properly safeguarded or secured upon removal from the premises.

Neighbors observed unknown individuals rummaging through and removing items from the property after our belongings were placed outside. Despite my diligence in attempting to secure the property and retrieve what remained, numerous items of significant financial and sentimental value were unlawfully taken.

Based on my review and inventory of the missing property, the total estimated value of the stolen and damaged items amounts to approximately Seven Thousand Dollars (\$7,000.00). This includes my child's personal PC computer setup, PlayStation console, full clothing inventory, and various other personal effects.

I bring these matters to the Court's attention as these events constitute additional, direct, and substantial harm stemming from the execution of the writ. The loss of my child's personal property, electronics, and essential items has imposed serious hardship upon our family. As such, I respectfully request that this Honorable Court permit me to proceed with retrieving the full financial value of the damages and losses incurred — and nothing less — as part of any further proceedings or remedy available u...
