MOTION TO ADD DEFACTO PARTIES VERIZON AND THE US GOVERNMENT

The basis of the findings of Palmetto Health/Prisma Health was that Appellant was trying to get paid in South Carolina for a Verizon Federal Contract with the FBI and the US Intelligence Community for a specialized Video Management System for specific classified Federal Buildings he was assigned at Verizon which his own brother thought was a lost cause. The complexity of the case is it took 4 years to clear high courts in Florida and Maryland on rental car conflicts with Dollar with terminating orders. Before the orders by three high courts Verizon wouldn't allow him to return to work. I was effectively suspended from work for four years with no pay while the courts decided the case because a Texas US District Judge denied him an emergency hearing in Austin, Texas on the National Security Program. **Furthermore, Mr. Obama personally made the bid award to his own engineer assigned to his own account and therefore would have had to testify or sign some sort of letter in support such as a stipulation.**

Dr. Jeffrey Raynor who does not have a US Intelligence clearance despite contracting with Ft. Jackson for specific unusual patient services, refused to take Appellants discussion of his bid project, and his employment at Verizon Federal as proof and **REFUSED TO CALL VERIZON FOR EMPLOYMENT VERIFICATION BOTH PERSONALLY AND THROUGH COUNSEL.**

Appellant notes that Dr. Raynor despite making no effort to validate Appellants discussion with him, that he simply found he was delusional and without basis in fact. He then proceeded to steal more than 300K from the US Government for his malpractice, the average amount he claimed he billed for each and every patient at Palmetto Health Richland 13.

Since Appellant was not allowed to cross-examine Dr. Raynor and his RESIDENT doctor in training Ms. Nagle his original statement stood. Furthermore, even after Mr. Bartlett was hired he made no effort to review the original finding entered by Judge Smiley who entered temporary orders before a trial on the merits.

ISSUES

Under the 11th Amendment to the US Constitution and its incorporation under the 14th Amendment, James R. Stritzinger had **(1) no rights to request relief** from the US Government and therefore had no standing to sue for benefits.

Judges Belton, and Smiley have no rights to sue the US Government for US Social Security Benefits using their own State Expert to steal from the US Government. Appellant believes that STATE JUDGES who do not have US Congressional powers to oversee US statute must transfer all cases to Federal Magistrates for initial benefit findings, even if they eventually get the cases back to administer.

Furthermore, for the same reason the US Government has to be a party to this case as Judges Smiley, Belton, and Newman **(2) had no Jurisdiction OVER THIS CASE IN THE FIRST PLACE.**

Relief Requested

Appellant believes that Verizon has to be a party to this specialized claim not just to defend its own employee for work assigned by his manager, but to defend the work requested by the US government as legitimate US Government business.

Appellant seeks the court correct the docket, and order Verizon and US Government counsel to appear.

Appellant prays for a remand to the trial court with the correct parties and resources to have an important trial which impacts a significant amount of business not just in South Carolina but in every state involving Medicaid, and SSA patient recoveries.

AFFADAVIT OF JOHN S. STRITZINGER

"My name is John S. Stritzinger and I have more than 20 years of video experience at Baby Bell companies including Cincinnati Bell, USWest/Centurylink/Vyvx, and Verizon. Additionally I was in charge of branch video systems in Network Architecture for all 6000+ sites at Bank of America.

The bid I received from the FBI while at Verizon was only taken by my department because one of our partners who was the incumbent provider for the FBI asked for our help on specialty infrastructure for THEIR bid which we had to modify to support the US Secret service. The President of the United States Barrack Obama decided to pay for the system the FBI wanted through Defense contracts, and that required that he be personally involved as commander in chief.

I spoke to Dr. Jeffrey Raynor, and Ms. Noggle a resident in training in his program in his office for approximately 6mins a day, every day, and never once in 90 days did he take the time to validate anything I said to him. While visiting their center more than three patients died to overmedication issues. He said he usually doubles the dose as most patients spit out or hide pills he prescribes and they cant forcibly monitor every pill.

I have a degree in a Medical related field in organic chemistry and I believe he is generally incompetent. Furthermore he told me specifically he is not a psychologist and has no training to evaluate specific issues bothering patients. He told me he was specifically focused on patient issues which prevent them from going to work or taking care of their own basic needs. Some serious patients in his care could not manage basics of human life like eating, showering, using the toilet and functionally below toddlers in their 8th year. Others have nervous ticks, and other characteristics which make social interactions impossible. In my case, I told him unless I resolve the issue with Verizon I could no longer at an ILEC, or in Federal contracting, and most of my business contacts would not speak to me anymore.

When I told him I literally had the highest level engineering job in America and what Mr. Asiedu did is indefensible considering that Verizon could have withheld small amounts from pay for any issues with expense reports as garnishments. For example when you make 12K dollars a month in salary, a 700 rental car expense per month is less than 15% of a single 6K paycheck and could have been garnished without a criminal complaint. The steps he took were without sanction and without regard for human safety. Mr. Asiedu told me he was trying to use that process so he could rehire someone else in his department which was blocked due to a slowdown in Bids received into the organization. Ms. Zeleniak who as the department head had effectively moved me temporarily out of Mr. Asiedu's team because he did not have a sufficient security clearance to deal with the FBI and the Whitehouse, and that effectively ended his career with the Federal Program. He was a 1st generation American, and although you can work in civil accounts, you cannot be a named party of a national security program which is a term and condition of most Federal bids.

Mr. Asiedu could have just let me go with two weeks pay, and I would have traveled back to my home in Texas. You literally need to understand in 30 years I have never seen anyone in any company treated in that manner except in some restaurants who

usually do not pay severance to employees who have worked there less than 1 year. This is not a Verizon practice however for an FTE, and I believe he did it on his own because he said his dad was a lawyer and worked at the Virginia Supreme Court.

In other words, after being barred from working on his own employees project due to clearance by Verizon corporate lawyers, Mr. Asiedu sought out his own family outside counsel to handle the dispute as the expenses on this bid were being charged to his budget and not to Ms. Zeleniaks. To my knowledge he never asked Ms. Zeleniak for relief. In fact his boss Scott Matosco who does have a security clearance approved the project and his whole travel agenda.

I believe Dr. Raynor could have only arrived at his finding after getting a negative response at work history at Verizon and Bank of America. Some patients actually sit and tell someone who contracts with the US Army that they are ex-green berets and the like as a basis of everything they say to their families and friends while he has access to military records.

Dr. Raynor used the hearsay statement of James R. Stritzinger Jr. who completely denied I even worked for Verizon. He told Dr. Raynor I was claiming to work on CIA projects which is why I was traveling in Florida, and other places.

I was located at Verizon at 22001 Loudoun County parkway which was directly next to Dulles Airport on approach, and the cost to fly direct to Charleston was more than 1000.00 and rental cars 90/day while flying to Orlando and driving to Charleston was 99.00 for a flight, and 20/day for a rental car with Dollar Rental car. The only caveat was I had to stay over a weekend. I drove to Charleston on Monday morning after staying to free nights with my parents at the cost of 2 extra car rental days. The total cost to arrive in Charleston was approximately 150.00 versus over 1000 plus hotels the other way. I met with the Verizon vendor on Monday afternoon approximately June or July of 2013 with a vendor called Executive Technologies. I saved the company more than 1000.00 in traveling a bit differently and got to see my parents too. It creates a bit more complexity in how you manage resolving your expense reports but this is common in the SAP Concur program used by Verizon and which I had used at Bank of America as well.

Worse Mr. Asiedu notified and wrote terrible things to Fidelity HR which is the outsourced provider for Bank of America, Cincinnati Bell and others. In other words third parties can send subpoenas to Fidelity for more than one workplace, and they might actually respond without Bank of America/CBT approval.

Mr. Raynor has in-house counsel and could have validated workplace information via Fidelity and Mr. Asiedu's letter in less than 1 week formally in writing, and probably within an hour over the phone. He made no effort at all, nor did Ms. Noggle who had no life experience outside of her job.

Competent counsel could have cured all these issues in just a few kind words to any of the judges involved. They start with the presumption in a medical situation that everything the patient says is a lie. They seek professional inputs on the facts and they didn't get any. Furthermore, the person claiming to be a Guardian Ad Litem was in fact acting as the outsourced state prosecutor who was only seeking to recoup costs for the State.

I believe that both the Ad Litem, and Mr. Bartlett should be disbarred, and Mr. Raynor should lose his license. He had no HR training, no psychology certifications or experience and he's handing out pills to everyone of various strengths. He is in my opinion nothing more than a Pharmaceutical lab executive who is testing drugs on experimental patients some of which died. He is far from being someone who should be certifying South Carolina professionals.

In Texas psychiatrists have to be psychologists first. I believe you have to have at least a BS in psychology to move on to psychiatry. South Carolina is making psychiatrists out of poor medical students who have failed out of other specialties and don't want to be GPs or ER doctors or cant for some reason. This therefore is a systematic problem leading to grand larceny of US Government funds by people like James R. Stritzinger who should have to seek relief in Federal District Courts rather than State Courts which have no statutory power.

A lady in a wheel chair was so heavily medicated she couldn't open her mouth to eat, and she literally died while I watched in shock, she was already catatonic and nurses at Palmetto were trying to make her take more pills.

James R. Stritzinger had no standing to request relief of his brother who was seeking a US District Court order to return to work after two state courts had dismissed Verizon and Dollar Rentals criminal action which was originated by them. State courts should have not reviewed the Federal Business contracts of Verizon and the US Government but refused to transfer and enter a findings requiring a US District Court review which could have been done in a ½ day setting as Appellant had four high court orders from the Maryland Supreme Court, Maryland Circuit Court, Florida Supreme Court, and Florida 5th Circuit Court of Appeals among others all handled by John S. Stritzinger pro-se. In other words I won two criminal circuit proceedings, two medical cases, and got more than four affirmations from high courts in this process which is significant in itself. The Supreme Courts of Pennsylvania, Delaware, MD, and Florida all signed orders along with the 4th, and 5th court of appeals in this case. It took a significant amount of time and experience. However only the MD, and FL cases were restrictions to returning to Verizon Federal as an engineer where I served with distinction and where I won two of three bids I was assigned in two years. Furthermore Mr. Obama agreed to pay for all

of my work as time and materials charges up to the last day in office so Verizon could bill all my time at 3X what my salary was on an existing contract with the US Military.

I have been treated very poorly by Judges in South Carolina none of which have simply called the docket and requested witnesses to come forward and testify. The reason is Verizon didn't show for trial and when I asked for a default Judgement which simply allowed me to go back to work, the Judges couldn't believe it was that simple due to the high court wreckage. (Birch, Hood). In 2018 Verizon owed me 4 years pay or 500K dollars, and some sort of process to get my badge and my laptop back. Now we are dealing with costs for 10+ appellate appearances for Mr. Obama and Metadata location processing which constituted classified upgrades to the original FBI bid."
