**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO
SATISFY COSTS OF FILING FEE**

Appellant, Alonzo C. Jeter, III, comes hereby respectfully moves this Honorable Court for an extension of time to satisfy the cost of the filing fee in this action.

On April 17, 2025, Appellant filed a Motion to Proceed In Forma Pauperis. The Court denied the Motion by way of an Order dated May 30, 2025, and provided Appellant fifteen days to pay the filing fee. Appellant received a copy and notice of the Court’s decision regarding this matter on June 3, 2025, by and through the Lee Correctional Institution Legal Mail System.

Appellant is an indigent prisoner who is in-fact employed within the South Carolina Department of Corrections. However, Appellant is unable to receive compensation for his labor due to South Carolina law. Consequently, Appellant has had to look to others for financial assistance. Appellant has been diligently seeking assistance of someone who will provide him the funding.

It does seem that Appellant has been successful in his endeavor to acquire funding for the filing fee; however, he is unable to provide this payment to the Court in the quick time of the fifteen-day allowance. Appellant prays for an additional amount of time in which to satisfy this fee.

As there are three people collaboratively providing the funds, there has been an issue with the logistics of gathering the funding into one basket and then the appropriate avenue for providing to the Court.


The thought was that the funding would be able to be provided to the Court by way of online payment(s). However, Appellant was recently informed that online payment is not an option due to the fact that the E-Filing System must be used, and the E-Filing System is only available to attorneys.

Appellant has also been informed that the South Carolina Department of Corrections' – Lee Correctional Institution's mailroom personnel is refusing to allow a check or money order to be mailed to him and that he be allowed to come to the institution's mailroom with a pre-addressed postage prepaid envelope for mailing the check or money order out to the Clerk of Court's Office.

If making a payment online is an option, please do inform me Appellant of this and of the means of doing so. Also, Appellant asks to be informed of exactly who a check or money order should be made payable to. (Jenny A. Kitchings, Clerk of Court or South Carolina Court of Appeals).

As such, Appellant prays the Court will grant him an extended period of fifteen days in which to satisfy the filing fees.

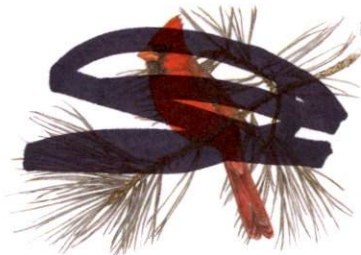
