Pursuant to the Court's order dated May 22, 2025, I respectfully submit the following status update in the above-referenced matter.

Attorney Matthew Billingsley remains the attorney of record in the Charleston County Court of Appeals. He was officially relieved as my attorney in the South Carolina Court of Appeals on February 19, 2025, but did not file to be relieved in the Charleston County Court of Common Pleas until May 21, 2025. Since then, the court has denied his motion to withdraw as my counsel.

The voicemail I received from him on June 13, 2025 at 3:56 p.m. followed by an email indicated that opposing counsel had two cases scheduled for June 17th: one in person and mine, which was virtual and needed to be rescheduled. He suggested rescheduling my hearing for June 20th, but I was unavailable due to a scheduled medical procedure. Initially, this hearing was set for June 17th, but it was canceled and then rescheduled for June 6th. However, it was canceled again due to a scheduling conflict with opposing counsel and subsequently rescheduled for June 17th once more, but it was canceled again. As of my last communication with him, there has been no new date set for the hearing.
