COUNT ONE - MURDER

That DAVID LAMAR THOMPSON did in Greenville County, on or about the 23rd day of May 2014, unlawfully and with malice aforethought kill JENNIFER YOUNGBLOOD by means of stabbing her multiple times, and that JENNIFER YOUNGBLOOD died as a proximate result thereof. This is in violation of §16-3-10 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.

COUNT TWO – POSSESSION OF A WEAPON DURING THE COMMISSION OF A VIOLENT CRIME

That DAVID LAMAR THOMPSON did in Greenville County, on or about the 23rd day of May, 2014, possess or visibly display a knife during the commission or attempted commission of a violent crime, to wit: Murder. This is in violation of § 16-23-0490 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.
