ORDER

This Court dismissed this appeal on February 18, 2025, after Appellants failed to provide proof of timely ordering the transcript. No timely motion to reinstate was received and the remittitur was properly sent on March 6, 2025. On March 21, 2025, Appellant filed a motion to recall the remittitur. A remittitur cannot be recalled except upon "a very strong showing . . . that the remittitur was sent down through some mistake or inadvertence *on the part of this Court or its officer.*" *State v. Keels*, 39 S.C. 553, 17 S.E. 802 (1893) (emphasis added). Appellant has failed to make such a showing. Appellants' motion, therefore, is denied.
