

Travis Gathers before the Court of Appeals on May 14, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Matthew Darazs v. The State with this Court on May 7, 2025. Counsel filed the Brief of Respondent in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of James L. Williford with this Court on May 1, 2025.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


