Subject: Request for Assistance in Obtaining Tony Lin's Residential and Driver's License Address from York County Sheriff's Office

Dear Honorable Court:

I respectfully request the Court's assistance in contacting York County Sheriff's Office Investigator James Voytko to obtain the home address and driver's license address of Tony Lin (also known as Lin Yi Tong).

It has been more than a year since I requested a restraining order for my safety, but due to delays and non-cooperation from Detective Huang (also from the sheriff's office), I have been unable to serve the legal

documents to Tony Lin. Detective Huang refused to provide Tony Lin's residential address for service, despite my repeated requests.

Detective James Voytko previously promised me that if the court contacted him directly, he would provide Tony Lin's address. This is critical so I can complete service of court documents by mail.

I sincerely ask the Court to call or write to Investigator Voytko and obtain Tony Lin's home address and driver's license address as soon as possible, so I may proceed with the legal service.

On Wednesday July 5, 2023 I was dispatched to speak with a one Kong Jian Lin of Fort Mill, SC, regarding a past assault that occurred on March 29, 2021 at the Cherry Sushi Bar located at 4034 Charlotte Highway Clover, SC, York County. Kong reported that his boss, "Tony", Yi Tong Lin, hit him in the ribs and caused injury that lasted for several weeks. Kong had to go to the doctor and prescribed medicine for pain. Kong reported that he confronted Tony about it and Tony had him lie to an insurance company that he got hurt from a door hitting him. Kong also reported that Tony said that he has recordings of him, though it is not certain what the recordings contain. Tony denies hitting Kong.

There is a language barrier. Kong is now an American citizen but was born in China and speaks limited English. It appears that this incident has effected Kong's life in several ways. It is unknown why Kong is now coming forward with this information but it is very apparent that it has caused him emotional distress and anxiety. Kong brought with him several papers from the hospital, an affidavit in Chinese, instructions that he is looking to make a police report in English, and a recording of a conversation on a cassette tape. That tape contains a conversation of some sort between him and Tony, but, it is all in Chinese.

I will have to turn this report over to CID to look into further. A Chinese interpreter will be needed.
