**SECOND MOTION FOR EXTENSION
 OF TIME TO ORDER TRANSCRIPT**

COMES NOW the Appellant, Kenneth Jordan Bell, by and through his undersigned attorney, respectfully moves this Honorable Court to grant this Second Motion for Extension of Time to Order Transcript in support of states as follows:

1. The initial Affidavit of Indigency was forwarded to Appellant for signature. Said affidavit was returned to counsel with original signature but was not notarized.

9. This motion is made in good faith and not for the purposes of unnecessary delay.

WHEREFORE, Appellant moves for an order granting a second thirty (30) day time period to order the transcript, making it due on November 20, 2013.


