

ORDER

This appeal arises out of an order of the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission affirming the order of the Single Commissioner. This matter is dismissed without prejudice pursuant to *Rhame v. Charleston Cnty. Sch. Dist.*, 412 S.C. 273, 278, 772 S.E.2d 159, 162 (2015) (noting Rule 203(b)(6) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules is "expressly incorporated into the regulations of the Commission" and the Rule "clearly envisions a procedure for seeking rehearing before the Appellate Panel.") and *Hudson v. Hudson*, 290 S.C. 215, 216, 349 S.E.2d 341, 341–42 (1986) ("[I]n the event timely post-trial motions are filed under Rule 59, simultaneously with or subsequent to the filing of a Notice of Appeal, the appellant shall notify the Clerk of this Court in writing. Upon receipt of such notice, the appeal shall be dismissed without prejudice. Any party can appeal within ten (10) days after the order disposing of the post-trial motions. A second filing fee will not be collected from a party who previously appealed."). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
