

ORDER

On April 16, 2025, the court granted a motion to unseal the Union County Clerk of Court's file in 2020-CP-44-00104 for the limited purpose of completing the record on appeal. The order also stated, "These documents shall be placed in a supplemental record on appeal, which will allow them to be sealed at this court should a party so move. On May 8, 2025, Appellants moved to file the record on appeal and supplemental record out of time. After careful consideration, the record on appeal and supplemental record are accepted as filed. On May 12, 2025, Respondent Department of Social Services (Respondent DSS) moved to seal the supplemental record on appeal. Respondents Tammy Gaye Causey Dalsing and Edward Anthony Dalsing (Respondent Dalsings) filed a return joining in the motion. Appellants did not file a return. After careful consideration, we grant the motion to seal the supplemental record on appeal filed on May 8, 2025.

We are in receipt of Respondent DSS's motion to supplement the record filed May 28, 2025; Respondent Dalsings' motion to supplement the record filed May 28, 2025; the second supplemental record filed June 17, 2025, and Appellant's motion to supplement the record on appeal filed June 23, 2025. for a response.
