ORDER

Through retained counsel, Appellant filed a notice of appeal, challenging his criminal convictions and sentences. Appellant's retained counsel moved to be relieved and for counsel to be appointed to represent Appellant for his appeal. On May 16, 2024, we issued an order holding the appeal in abeyance for thirty days to allow the Office of Appellate Defense to screen this case.
