Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Craig Lamar Edwards with the Court of Appeals on May 19, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Abin Lee Lowman v. The State with the Supreme Court on May 12, 2025. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Cleveland Maxwell with the Court of Appeals on April 30, 2025

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty-day extension, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances.
