
Dear Mr. Graves,

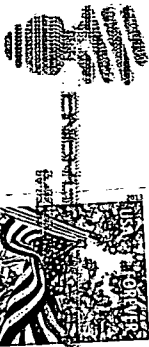
