MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Mosley with the Court of Appeals on April 23, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of Holly Jo Thompson v. The State with the Supreme Court on April 7, 2024.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


