ORDER

On March 10, 2025, Appellant filed an amended initial brief. On May 14, 2025, Respondent filed a motion to dismiss this appeal because Appellant's amended initial brief does not comply with Rule 208 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. Appellant filed a return, opposing dismissal, explaining her brief's deficiencies are the result of her lack of legal training, and asking this court to appoint counsel for her.¹ After careful consideration, we deny Respondent's motion to dismiss this appeal. However, we strike Appellant's amended initial brief. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended initial brief that complies with Rule 208. Failure to comply will result in dismissal of the appeal.
