

Designation of Matter to Be Included in the Record
of Appeal.

Plaintiff, Christopher M. Kennan (herein also, me, "my" or "I"), proposes the following be included in the record of Appeal (Due to the fact that I am a pro se inmate who can not access the Courts ECF filing system, I can't specifically cite these ECF #'s):

- ① Complaint - used to show fundamental state and Federal Constitutional issues are implicated in this case; is relevant for tolling issues - including related, and already dismissed cases
- * ② Defendants provided no answer because the lower court refused to file my Complaint, assign a case number, issue summons and because my in forma pauperis application was repeatedly denied despite my qualifications. This is actually the entire basis of the appeal before this court. No defendants have been served to date.
- ③ All orders from the Honorable R. Ferrell Cothran, Jr. Denying my in forma pauperis applications, motions to reconsider written to the Clarendon County Court of Common Pleas related to case no. 2024-CP-14-00548 and others listed in Complaint.
- ④ Order dated Mar 19, 2025 for Appellate Case No. 2024-001861, from the South Carolina Court of Appeals ordering the lower court to "perform... ministerial duties... file" my Complaint. This order placed my case in abeyance. No one ever wrote to inform me this case is no longer being held in abeyance.
- ⑤ Handwritten letter written to the lower court by Plaintiff - replied to by Clarendon County Clerk of Court (Court of Common Pleas), along with MS. Shanita Brangman (clerk) handwritten reply dated 12/16/24 informing me that my appeal has been denied. Though we are working through this appeal currently.
- ⑥ All documents and exhibits sent to me by the lower court or the S.C. Court of Appeals - or by me to these Courts discussing how to proceed with and prosecute my case.



Furthermore, due to SCDC policy disallowing photocopies of my handwritten legal docs, I don't have an identical copy to be stamped and returned to me. However,


if you would bill me for a stamped copy I will pay for it to be sent to me if you are willing/able to do this for me.
