Dear Counsel:

I am writing to follow up on the September 17 deficiency letters from our Clerk's office.

In those letters the court identified instances in which the documents you filed did not comply with the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure. We have determined that those deficiencies are serious enough that we must dismiss your appeal if they are not corrected. We have already given you ten days to make the corrections. If you fail to correct these deficiencies within **ten** days of the date of this letter, your appeal will be dismissed. The deficiencies we previously identified were:


- The parties have been using inconsistent captions on documents filed with this court. To comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR, the caption on all document must read as follows:

Edward D. Sloan, Jr., individually, and on behalf of all others similarly situated, and South Carolina Public Interest Foundation, Appellants,

v.

South Carolina Department of Revenue and James F. Etter, its Director, Respondents.

If either party believes this is not the correct title of this case, you must offer an alternative in writing within 5 days.
