

ORDER

On appeal, Appellant challenges a circuit court order denying his request for an order precluding the release of his jail calls to the media pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act. On May 22, 2025, Respondent filed a motion to dismiss this appeal, arguing the order on appeal is interlocutory and not immediately appealable. On May 29, 2025, Appellant filed a return, arguing the order is a final judgment and immediately appealable under section 14-3-330 of the South Carolina Code (2017). After careful consideration, we deny the motion to dismiss. However, this order merely allows the appeal to proceed at this time and does not finally determine whether the underlying order is subject to immediate review. The parties are free to address these questions of appealability in their briefing as the appeal progresses.
