**PETITIONER GIBBS INTERNATIONAL, INC.’S
SECOND MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPLY TO THE RETURN
TO THE PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI**

Pursuant to Rule 240(a) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Petitioner Gibbs International, Inc. (“Gibbs”), with the consent of Respondents Sarmad Harake and Eurosa, Inc. (collectively, “Respondents”), respectfully requests an extension of time of ten (10) days to file its Reply to Respondents’ Return to the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari.

Gibbs filed its Petition for a Writ of Certiorari on April 10, 2025. On June 27, 2025, Respondents’ filed their Return to Gibbs’ Petition for a Writ of Certiorari. On July 1, 2025, Gibbs filed its First Motion for Extension of Time to file its Reply to the Respondents’ Return. On

July 2, 2025, the Court issued an order granting Gibbs a ten (10) day extension of time to file its Reply. Pursuant to Rule 242(g), SCACR, and the Court's July 2, 2025 order, Gibbs' Reply to the Respondents' Return is due to be filed with the Court on or before July 17, 2025.

As a result of Gibbs' counsels' work schedule, Gibbs respectfully contends that good cause exists for a ten (10) day extension of time to file its Reply to the Respondents' Return to the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari.

This is Gibbs' second motion for an extension of time. Counsel for Gibbs have conferred with Counsel for the Respondents, and Respondents consent to this motion.

WHEREFORE, Gibbs respectfully requests the Court issue an Order granting its request for an extension of time of ten (10) days within which to file its Reply to Respondents' Return to Gibbs' Petition for a Writ of Certiorari.
