

ORDER

On June 12, 2025, Appellant filed a supplemental record in compliance with this court's May 20, 2025 order. We accept the supplemental record as filed. The supplemental record filed by Appellant was not paginated. In order to ensure consistency between the final briefs, we determine the email will be considered supplemental record page 1, the screenshot will be considered supplemental record page 2, and the paystubs will be considered supplemental record page 3. We direct the parties to use these page numbers when filing their final briefs.

On June 18, 2025, Appellant filed a motion to require Respondent to supplement the record with "pay rates during participation by week or [bi]-weekly and verification of prevailing wage rate by the Department of Employment and Workforce, Employment Security Commission and Occupational Employment Statistics." Respondent did not file a return. After careful consideration, we deny Appellant's motion. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The [r]ecord on [a]ppeal shall include all matter designated to be included by any party under Rule 209 [of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules] . . . and [t]he [r]ecord shall not, however, include matter which was never presented to the lower court or tribunal.").

Within twenty days of the date of this order, the parties shall serve and file their final briefs.
