





ORDER

On December 19, 2024, this court dismissed this appeal because Appellant failed to file a designation of matter in compliance with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.¹ On December 27, 2024, Appellant filed a motion to reinstate his appeal, which we construe as a petition for rehearing.
