MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO  
PRODUCE TRANSCRIPT

NOW COMES Appellant, by and through his undersigned counsel, moving for a 30-day extension of time for production and delivery of the transcript in the above-captioned case. The transcript was ordered on April 9, 2025 and was, after, an initial extension, due July 9, 2025. The Appellant is in the process of paying for the transcript but needs an additional 30 days to make full payment in light of the transcript's length. The Appellant's sister has the funds available to pay that she has received by virtue of a settlement involving a motor vehicle accident. However, because some of the money is for the care of her minor child, the court has ordered that a structured settlement be in place, and that process should be complete within the next 30 days, allowing her to pay for the full transcript.
