MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Jeffrey Michael George with the Court of Appeals on May 30, 2025. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Stephen J. Green with the Court of Appeals on May 22, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of Willie M. Williams v. The State with the Supreme Court on May 14, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Carlos Ruiz v. The State with the Supreme Court on May 1, 2025.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


