Dear Ms. Kitchens,

We are pro se and strive to do exactly as you and the Court want or direct. We strictly abided by the Briefing Schedule of the Court, urged by Judge Few specifying no continuances unless specifically granted by the Court. None were granted. Our final brief was thus planned and submitted to you on Sept. 3, 2013 in full compliance with the deadline. Blue Ridge has to date failed to submit its final Brief and they not only have a team of some 8 well-paid lawyers plus legal assistants and staff but were adamant regarding the initiation of this lawsuit for alleged debt (jury-determined not to be in existence or valid) in a 3-day jury trial but equally adamant about the costly appeal.

It is only, therefore, fair that their appeal be dismissed with prejudice as we previously moved AND that our sought relief be granted. This unjust lawsuit by Blue Ridge has consumed over 6+ years of our lives and peace, despite being "excellent" customers of Blue Ridge for 25+ years.

They never correctly substituted or added counsel; they failed to meet deadlines to which we were held; and they abused the justice system and us. We pray you take the only right action and end their appeal with sanctions and grant ours.

It has been over a month and a week that Blue Ridge has missed the Brief deadline. Thank you.
