Dear Judges Of The Court Of Appeals,

My name is Latausha Vanderhall and I am writing you today to bring to your attention that I informed the Honorable Judge Robert Hood that the Magistrate Court did not have jurisdiction to rule on the matter's at hand. That statement was made according to the South Carolina state law statute ss22-3-20. I also informed the Honorable Judge Hood that Attorney Robert Hartman III that drafted the deed for the property that has not yet been legally surveyed for Pro Se Respondent Alisha Davis, called the Magistrate Court in 2021 and informed the Honorable Chief Justice Feaster that Mrs. Shirley Vanderhall did not give Alisha anyone's property or home nor did she intend to. I Appellee Latausha Vanderhall, was then granted a stay. Prior to Attorney Hartman calling the Honorable Chief Justice Feaster, the Honorable Judge K. Washington initially ruled in favor of Alisha in the 2021 Notice To Quit. I was then informed that another hearing would be scheduled and during that next hearing the case was dismissed due to jurisdiction. It is my opinion and literally obvious that Alisha is using the court's and law enforcement to illegally steal my home that I am the legal sole owner of since 2001 that she has never been apart of owning in any way and to have me banned from the property that I am an heir to. In 2021, the case was dismissed because an error of the law was determined. Alisha was not deeded my home and she is not the owner, my mother never owned the home or property to be able to deed it to anyone. She is claiming to try and take my property as a bargaining tool so I can do what she wants me to and sign over a portion of my inheritance. I have submitted evidence showing her admit that in her own words and letters to the courts and myself. My home is a Jim Walter's stick built and it has never been permanently affixed to the property and it still is not to this day. I have been in this home and raised my children and grandchildren for 20 plus years, I am now disabled and if I lose my home and property I will be homeless and that would be a crime committed against me. Also, on the tax maps the tax assessors has the two separate homes under one address which is 1948 Bellfield Road and that is her home address. My home address is 1950 Bellfield Road and that address is not listed at all on the maps and I have sent that evidence in with my Motion also. I have submitted the necessary documents to the tax assessors to correct the problem that was not caused by me and it has not been addressed or corrected. I am pleading with the court to please look at my evidence and assist me with not illegally and unlawfully losing my home and property of 20 plus years, I would be extremely grateful. Thank you for your time.
