On July 16, 2025, this Court issued an unpublished decision in the above-referenced State's appeal affirming the circuit court's grant of immunity pursuant to the South Carolina Protection of Persons and Property Act. The State intends to file a petition for rehearing in this matter, and, pursuant to Rule 221(a) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, the petition would need to be served and filed no later than July 31, 2025. However, due to a heavy workload and my current assignments, I am requesting a combined first-and-second extension for a total of thirty days within which to serve and file the State's petition.
