
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The document has not been signed as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR.
- The appellant's initial brief must contain a table of contents and cases, statement of issues on appeal, statement of the case, standard of review, argument and conclusion pursuant to Rule 208(b)(1), SCACR.
- The cover page of your appellant's initial brief should contain only the caption/title and your contact information pursuant to Rule 267(a), SCACR.
- The caption does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the caption must match exactly with the one given below:

v.

Kyle Anthony Tracy, Appellant.
